Roy Harrison is Professor of Environmental Health at the University of Birmingham, UK, and part-time Strategic Theme Leader for Environment, Pollution and Human Health for the UK Natural Environment Research Council. His research interests focus primarily on air pollutants in the urban environment, ranging from studies of emissions through atmospheric processes to personal exposure and effects on human health. Recent work has been focused primarily on airborne particulate matter, including studies of engine exhaust in both the laboratory and the atmosphere, urban air quality processes through both measurement and modelling, personal exposure studies and collaborative studies of particle toxicology, epidemiology and human challenge. He has also been heavily engaged at the science/policy interface and is currently acting as an adviser to the UK government and World Health Organisation.
